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1. Introduction

The Atlantic Watergames have the objective of development of sports in the Atlantic Area, develop sporting and cultural exchanges and friendly relations in a competition by regions in several modalities.

The technical responsibility of the organization of the modality of Lifesaving Sport in the Atlantic Watergames 2013, will be the Portuguese Lifesaving Federation (FEPONS), held in Viana do Castelo from 16 to 18 July 2013, governed by the general rules of the Atlantic Watergames.

The rules applied in the Lifesaving Sports of the Atlantic Watergames 2013 will be the rules, standards and procedures of the competition manual of the International Life Saving Federation

2. Participation

The participation follows the general Atlantic Watergames regulation.

4. Registrations

Registrations are made in the site <http://www.jniea.eu> (contact@jniea.eu) until day 9 July 2013. The conditions of registration, follow the rules of the Atlantic Watergames 2013, and also this Regulation.

5. List of Participants

The entries of each athlete should be confirmed by the delegates of the team on 14 July, from 10:00 to 18:30 or 15 July from 10:00 to 17:00 at Pier Viana.

Delegates must bring proof of insurance coverage.

6. Equipment

All equipment must meet the standards of the International Lifesaving Federation. The organization will provide the Rescue Tubes used by athletes. The remaining equipment will be responsibility of the teams.

7. Competition Local

The competitions will take place at the Coral Beach in Viana do Castelo – Portugal.

8. Arbitration

The arbitration will be in charge of FEPONS judges and international referees.

9. Competition Jury

Protests and other situations inherent to the competition will be subject to evaluation and decision of the Competition Jury, composed by: Referee Competition, the Competition Director and a member of the Technical Department of FEPONS.

10. Structure of the Competition

The competition will be of direct final, taking into account the time criterion.

11. Scoring and Awards Ceremony

The scores in each class and category will be valid when at least five countries or regions are represented. The lifeguards classified in the first 3 places in each event will be awarded a medal. The system of classification of countries or regions will be the system of the International Committee (counting the number of gold medals earned by each country).

12. Omissions

Will be judged by the Organizing Committee.
